### Description Of Activities:

The Community Centre continues to facilitate a variety of local groups who offer a wide range of activities to the local community. Local Bowls club uses the Main Hall Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday mornings. Templeshannon Brownies used the Main Hall every Thursday Night (Holidays excluded). Slaney Kenpo ran Karate Classes every Monday & Wednesday Night, & Saturday Mornings. O'Brien School of Dancing ran a class in the Main Hall every Tuesday night. Shamrocks Penny GAA (Hurling & Football Club) continue to use the back room every Friday night for Penny Bank. Shamrocks Soccer Club used the Cafe every Monday night for the local Lotto. Wexford Local Development (Billy Murphy) hired the Main Hall on 21st January for Charities Regulatory Authority Information event. The Main Hall was used for a Polling Station (General Election) on February 26th. Albert Retail hired out the back room for training in April & October. Local Neighborhood Watch & Residents Committee used the Back Room for short meetings. Sheila Grace Dance Company continued in the Main Hall from March to June. The Community Cafe continued to provide low cost snacks to the local Community. A Manager, A Caretaker, Three part-time workers were maintained in the Cafe, while Four part-time workers maintained the Childcare. Safety Checks and Fire Drills were undertaken. Fire Extinguishers were upgraded in the Centre. Our Childcare Centre provides a high quality, accessible and affordable childcare service to the local community. All aspects of child development are encompassed in order to measure the development of the whole child. Children are provided with opportunities to explore, be creative, and develop social and cooperative skills in a safe, developmentally appropriate and nurturing environment.
